
What is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program that provides additional academic support and learning opportunities. Title I funds are allocated by the Kentucky Department of Education to local districts/schools based on percentages of students qualifying for free/reduced lunch.

If a school is designated as a School-wide Title I building, all students attending that school are eligible for Title I services. All Breckinridge County School District elementary schools and middle school are School-wide Title I Programs.

What services are provided with Title I Funds?

- focused instruction in reading and math
- extended learning opportunities (before, during, or after school)
- instructional materials
- teacher professional development
- family learning events
- opportunities for parent involvement

These services are planned by the individual schools.



Annual Parent Survey

An annual Parent Survey is given to all of our Title I families for feedback and suggestions. The findings produced by the annual evaluation are used to design strategies for school improvement and for revising the Parent Involvement Policy if needed.

As a Parent, you have the right...

- to know the qualifications of your child's teacher.
- to know when your child has a substitute teacher for more than four weeks and the qualifications of the teacher.
- to know how the school is rated on its state test scores.
- to understand the Kentucky State Standards and your child's test scores.
- to expect regular communication with your school in a language that you can understand.
- to work with other parents and teachers to develop a school-level parent compact between school and families to help ensure each child's academic success.
- to help plan how money for parent involvement should be spent.
- to work with other teachers, parents, and the school principal in developing a Comprehensive School Improvement Plan.
- to ask for a meeting with the principal or your child's teacher(s).
- to volunteer at the school.
- to join your school's PTO (Parent Teacher Organization).
