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ACT and SAT Assessment COVID-19 Protocols

1. All students will enter via the back bus ramp and door stops will be used to prevent constant touching of surfaces.
2. Examinees will be required to wear a mask at all times and must remain six feet apart at all times.
3. When checking in, examinees will be asked to remove their face covering to visually match their face to their photo ID.
4. We will use the classrooms in A hall for testing and rooms are limited to 9 students.
5. Students must be at least 6 feet apart in the testing rooms but must continue to mask per ACT recommendations.
6. Hand sanitizer and wipes will be available in every room and at check-in. Surfaces will be regularly cleaned.
7. All staff and all examinees must answer COVID-19 screener questions and must record temperatures.
8. Any staff or examinee answering yes to any of the COVID-19 screener questions or having a temperature above 100.5 will not be able to enter the test site. Record of this information will be kept.
9. All staff and examinees will be asked to contact ACT if they have been diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the taking the test.
10. All staff is required to wear masks and gloves throughout the day of testing. Gloves are recommended to be changed anytime material is distributed or collected.
11. COVID-19 signage will be posted at the bus ramp entrance, as well as in other areas of the testing site.
