The remote learning experience for the first week was a lot better than I anticipated. We had a high percentage of high school students participating in their classes this week. We realize we are still working through some internet issues, device issues, and some issues with uploading and downloading classwork on our end. Nonetheless, it was a great week at BCCHS! 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Our first week of remote learning flew by. As I mentioned earlier, the first week was a lot better than I had anticipated. We had a high number of students participate and I had many positive comments from our faculty and staff. There were a few issues and I will go over those at this time.

To start at the beginning, remote learning at BCCHS is through Google Classroom. Students have access to all their classes on their schedules through Google Classroom. For most classes, students were automatically enrolled into these classes and did not need to go to their email to enroll. However, there were a few classes that need you to go to your email and enroll. So, please check your email and check your Google Classrooms. You should have seven Google Classrooms unless you are co-oping or in credit recovery.

Students should expect a daily activity each day for every class. Please do not get this confused with an assignment every day. Each day will be different. There will be a wide variety of instructional strategies utilized during our remote learning experience. Students will have instructional strategies such as lectures, reading assignments, videos to watch, essays to write, exit slips, quizzes, and even online tests. Probably the most important point of this paragraph is to make sure students are checking their Google Classrooms each day and complete the task assigned.

We realize there may be some student confusion or misunderstandings during remote learning. Teachers are available to our students. BCCHS teachers are available from 8:00-11:00 and 12:00-3:00 each day. Teachers will also be available via Google Meet each day for one hour each day as well. This is a perfect opportunity for students to meet with their teachers and discuss anything they may be having trouble with.
