Good Sunday evening Tiger Nation!!! I hope this message finds everyone doing well, healthy, and excited about the start of in-person instruction in the Breckinridge County School District. I know we are excited about the return of students to the hallways of BCCHS! Please enjoy this week's Send-It Notification and Go Tigers!!!

Again, in-person instruction starts back tomorrow across our district. We will be restarting on our A/B plan with the A group going to school on Monday and Tuesdays and the B group going to school on Wednesday and Thursday. The high school will be delivering instruction utilizing a hybrid model. We will be serving our students in-person and serving our students that select to remain on our remote learning platform by continuing our Google Classroom approach that we have been using for the first five weeks of school.

We will continue to ensure the safety of all our students and staff in the building. All students entering the high school will go through a scanning station just like previous years. We will scan our students with hand-held metal detectors and, new this year, take the temperature of each student entering our building. We have changed our backpack policy and we are allowing students to carry their backpacks. Most students will be bringing a laptop or Chromebook with them and also water bottles and hand-sanitizer, so the need to carry a bookbag is necessary.

We have also had to change the location where our student drivers and students dropped off will enter high school. Student drivers and students being dropped off will use the same parking lots as previous years but will need to enter the high school at the gym location near the football locker room. We will have staff members outside to assist with this change.
