- The overall goal is to get our student-athletes the opportunity to play the sport they love.
- BCHS will follow guidelines and recommendations to ensure a healthy and safe environment for our student-athletes, coaches, and families. We know following these guidelines will eliminate the opportunity for some of our loyal supporters to attend some ball games, but in order to have a season, we feel we must be cautious.
- This plan involves our fall sports that have paid attendance: football, soccer, and volleyball
 - Segment 1: September 7 to September 26
 - Segment 2: September 28 to October 2
 - Segment 3: October 3 to Postseason
- For segment 1:
 - We are capping attendance at 20% capacity for all home games:
 - 4 tickets for Breckinridge County athlete (family only)
 - 2 tickets for Breckinridge County cheerleaders (family only)
 - 2 tickets for opponent players (family only)
 - No Students (unless family) during Segment 1
 - No Coaches Cards
 - No Tiger Hundred
 - All attendees must be socially distanced (6 feet apart)
 - Family units may sit together.
 - All attendees must be masked at all times
- All in attendance will have to purchase a ticket (\$5.00 per ticket)
 - Tickets will be on sale at the BCHS front desk.
 - Monday through Friday 8:00 to 3:00
 - No ticket sales at the gate
- All in attendance must have a ticket to enter the contest.
 - Every ticket will include attendees name, contact information, and symptom checklist for contact tracing purposes.
- All games will be live-streamed via Breck Live through YouTube. (No Charge)
- We will have the opportunity to loosen these requirements for segment 2 and segment 3.
