## 2021 Breckinridge County High School Graduation Plan

Graduation Date: Friday, May 28, 2021

Times: 5:30 CST and 7:30 CST

Breckinridge County High School will hold split-session commencement exercises for the Class of 2021 to safely deliver diplomas to our graduating class while allowing guests to attend.

### Number of Graduates

Total Students Participating: 160 (approximately)

- Total Students 5:30 Ceremony: 80 graduates (A through J)
- Total Students 7:30 Ceremony 80 graduates (K through Z)

### Crowd Capacity

- Crowd Capacity at 15% would allow us to have 480 guests per session. This would allow each graduate 6 tickets for guests to attend their graduation.
- Students will not count toward the 15% just like our athletic events.
- Faculty will not count toward the 15% and will be seated on the gym floor six feet apart.

\*\*\* We hope the percentage will be increased by May and in communication with the community we will address the capacity limitations.

### Masks and Social Distancing

- Graduates will be seated on the gym floor six feet apart and will be required to wear a mask.
- Faculty will be seated on the gym floor, spaced six feet apart, and required to wear a mask.
- Distinguished Guests (Stage Seats) will be placed in areas around the stage. We will only use the stage to hand out diplomas.
- Guests will be required to be socially distanced and seated six feet apart from other families.

### Parking for the Event

- BCHS administration will work with our city police department and our county sheriff's office to assist us in parking our guest vehicles and directing traffic on and off of US 60.

## Ceremony

- Welcome and recognition of guests
- National Anthem - performed virtually by the BCHS band on a recording
- Speeches
  - Salutatorian
  - Valedictorian
  - Superintendent
- Recognition of Top 3%
- Presentation of Diplomas
- Conferring of Diplomas

## Sanitizing

- BCHS Administration and custodial staff will sanitize at approximately 6:30 for the 7:30 graduation.

## 5:30 Ceremony

- Doors will not open until 5:00 for guests to prevent gathering.
- Guests will be directed to the gym from the bus ramp entrance and escorted to seating areas.

## 7:30 Ceremony

- BCHS Administration will open the doors at 7:00 for guests to enter the gymnasium. We will not allow individuals in the building until that time. We will have signage in the parking lots asking everyone to stay in their vehicles until 7:00.
- We will ask all individuals to clear the building immediately following the conclusion of the ceremony so the gym can be disinfected.
